

## SUPERIOR COURT OF CALIFORNIA COUNTY OF PLUMAS

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

There currently being no newspaper of general circulation in Plumas County, service of the notice of the hearing of a probate matter cannot be accomplished by publication as set forth in Probate Code Sections 8120 and 8121.

Therefore, the Court orders that posting of the notice of hearing may substitute for publication, by posting notices on the public bulletin board in the Quincy Courthouse, 520 Main St., Quincy, California, on the Public Notices page of the online site of Plumas News and on any other bulletin board in or near a public building (including a U.S. Post Office) in Plumas County.

The Court further orders that the party posting notice shall file a declaration setting forth who posted the notice, the locations of the posting or by Plumas News and that the posting was done for three consecutive weeks, concluding at least five (5) days before the hearing date.
